We are pleased to share some highlights of our work in 2024:

- Launched MVNC OnSite, a new program that brings our most popular professional development and teambuilding programs to nonprofits at their location, addressing their specific training needs.
- Launched MVNC OnDemand, our new e-learning platform with a 3-part workshop series specifically for nonprofit board members.
- Launched a new **Group Coaching** program giving Executive Directors access to a certified executive coach and the opportunity to discuss & create solutions for real-time challenges.
- Served a record 1,098 nonprofit professionals in 2024 through our Suite of Offerings workshops, leadership development programs, special networking events, and group training programs.
- Distributed 175 grant-funded scholarships for a myriad of training programs through the generosity of local foundation partners.
